



# FIRE WARDEN TRAINING

## Reasons Why

Fire Warden training is a vital part of your Fire Safety Procedure. The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (RRFSO) requires ‘the responsible person’ for fire safety to nominate a sufficient number of persons to assist in implementing the Fire Safety Procedure. All nominated Fire Wardens require suitable and sufficient training to carry out and understand their duties.

This course has been designed to meet and exceed the requirements placed upon you, the employer, under the RRFSO thus providing you peace of mind that you have covered a very important topic.

<p><b>Target Candidate</b></p>	<p>Existing designated Fire Wardens Existing fire safety responsible person/s. Employees taking on the above roles</p> <p>NOTE - It is best that the candidate has completed some basic fire safety training</p>
<p><b>Course Duration</b></p>	<p>This is a half day course which can be tailored to your needs and requirements. If you have specific extra requirements then the course may take longer. Extra time will need to be added if live fire training is to be carried out as well.</p>
<p><b>Assessment and Award</b></p>	<p>The candidates will be assessed via a test at the end of the course and all successful candidates will be awarded certification showing that they have undertaken a basic fire safety course.</p>

<b>Cost</b>	This course is traditionally an 'in house' course so charges will be dependant on location, duration and content. Once we have your requirements we can then furnish you with a competitive quote
<b>Venue</b>	This course is normally carried out at your site.
